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Life Enrichment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Indoor staff- led groups will increase to 20 Outdoor staff-led groups will increase to 50 Chapel services will resume virtually and live for up to 20 assisted living residents Entertainers will be allowed to live stream from the chapel via our in-house channel The Gift Shop will reopen the end of this month on a limited basis. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Social distancing, mask and proper hand hygiene are required.
Inside Visits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Guests can schedule visits by going to www.peabodyrc.setmore.com Guests are no longer required to have a negative COVID test result within 30 days prior to the visit of the scheduled visit. Residents are limited to two (2) guests per visit. Guests are required to stay in the designated areas only. Assisted Living visits will be in the Enrichment Center and Health Center visits will be located between door 8 and door 9 Each visit will be for 2 hours. Outdoor visits will continue through the remainder of the calendar year, weather permitting. A COVID test is not required for outside visits. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Social distancing, mask and proper hand hygiene are required. Guest screening continues. Guests may not congregate in public spaces. Guests must enter through Door 9 are not permitted to enter side doors in any other part of the building.
Day Excursions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Families/friends are allowed to take residents off campus for the day. All excursions need to be scheduled at least 72 hours in advance. Please contact the resident's social worker to make arrangements. Resident will no longer be required to self-isolate for 72 hours upon return or have a COVID test administered. Residents who leave on a day excursion with an overnight stay will be required to self-isolate for 14 days upon return. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Social distancing, mask and proper hand hygiene are required.

Small Groups/Holidays	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An independent living apartment home will be available for small group gatherings of 10 or less. Visits can be scheduled at www.peabodyrc.setmore.com. This unit will be available on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM. We will increase the frequency during the Holiday season to accommodate the Health Center residents who are unable leave the facility to attend family gatherings. Transportation of Health Care residents will be available if needed during the Holiday season. Resident will no longer be required to self-isolate for 72 hours upon return or have a COVID test administered. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Social distancing, mask and proper hand hygiene are required. POA/Guardian will need to sign off on small group events A list of attendees must be submitted prior to the event If you are not feeling well or are experiencing the common symptoms of COVID, we ask that you please do not attend the gathering
Dining	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dining capacity has increased to 50% in Assisted Living Health Center dining rooms will remain closed until we are COVID free for 14 days The bistro is open for both AL and HC residents 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Social distancing, mask and proper hand hygiene are required. Masks may be removed once you are at your table. No self-service areas. No charge for delivery to apartments. No guests in dining venues.
Hospice & Ancillary Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will reopen our facility to Hospice and other ancillary services such as podiatry, dentistry and ophthalmology beginning October 12, 2020 Hospice & Ancillary must be tested for COVID based on the positivity rate for Wabash County. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Social distancing, mask and proper hand hygiene are required.
Doctor Appointments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assisted Living residents may now drive themselves to scheduled doctor's appointments If attending anywhere other than the scheduled appointment, the resident will be required to self-isolate for 72 hours upon return. After 72 hours, a COVID test will be administered. The resident or family will be responsible for this cost 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Social distancing, mask and proper hand hygiene are required.
